## A list of some of our recent and ongoing improvements!


- We have grown by 13 employees in the last 8 months.
- NSI's training program has been refined to eliminate all subjective avenues.
- NSI's training program now includes a dedicated & proprietary GEPHC specific 48hour classroom training room to include written tests and certificate's proving proficiency.
- NSI has increased our proof of proficiencies from a three to a five-tier program with stored electronic proof.
- Classroom training now includes training from Hilti, Uniprise, Greenlee, & Commscope reps.
- Our QMS program has been significantly improved and signed off on by GE compliance partner Comply Works to include OSHA approved programs as our new and improved "Stop Work Program" & refined "Worker Welfare Program".

## A list of some of our recent and ongoing improvements!

- The NSI vehicle fleet is being systematically replaced by our new more green & fuel efficient fleet of vans.
- Our uniforms have been upgraded to now include two different options. Both of which are high quality and look very professional.
- We now store all electronic records (such as test results) in three separate locations for triple redundancy.
- We moved our email server platform to an optional IMAP to better sync our devices to our different email devices.
- We continue to be prepared to take on overflow work in other regions which we have successfully done on the east coast and in Texas for both of the other two contractors. This helps ensure GEPHC doesn't miss a beat with scheduling and project timelines.
- We continue to improve and modify our mission based on feedback from GE employees and upper management.





Hands on training is a huge part of NSI's 48hour education program!




At the NSI National Education Center we spend hours and hours doing the following terminations in a supervised classroom setting:

- 1.) Unicam Fiber
- 2.) Fusion spliced fiber
- 3.) Series-6 & Series-11 coax
- 4.) Twisted pair cables (UTP)
- 5.) Air-Cell Connectors



We have a permanent classroom fusion splicer and test kit in our training center. Teams get to go through the entire process in our lab!

An actual live CH tele system is powered up for direct comparison to the IDP in the NSI National **Education Center!** Multiple splitter boards and data racks with data and fiber switches are live. Again, GEPHC is the complete focus of our education center!









We built a break room in our education center because breaks are important to maintaining focus!
